### **Annual General Meeting**

### Major Activities Organized by PTA in 2016-17

The annual dinner was held at the School Hall on 25 February 2017. A guided tour to



the newly opened school history gallery was arranged before dinner, with about 123 visitors. It was a great pleasure to have our old boy Dr. Wong Chung Kwong as our honorable guest to kick off the "Walk with You" – 15,500 Steps Challenge Fund Raising event, which lasted till 24 March 2017. Over 260 students, parents and teachers participated in the annual dinner, taking up 22 tables.
